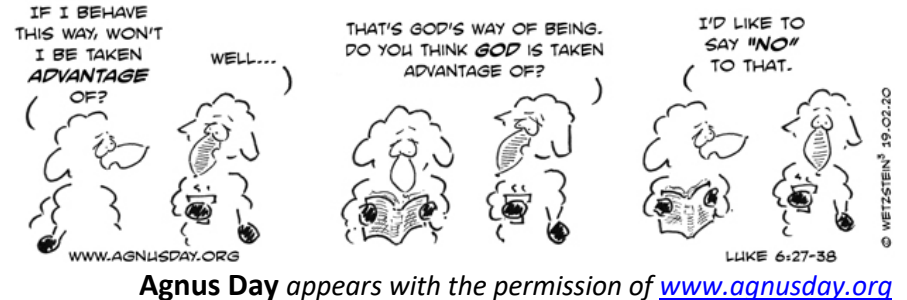

## Ananias' Theological Thoughts

Lent is one of the times in the church year that I'm starting to understand more as I become an older and more mature bulldogge.

I realize that during those 40 days that lead up to Good Friday, we should take time to really look at ourselves, what we are doing and what we have done, and if it is in line with Christ's commands. I know that working his sermon for this Sunday has been tough for My Big Guy because these teachings from Jesus are really, really hard.
