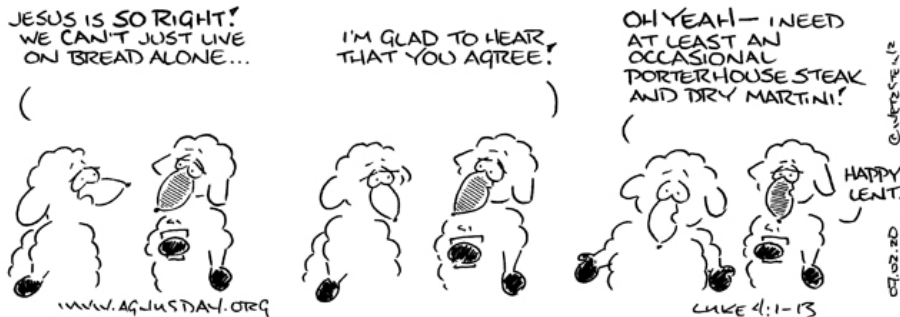

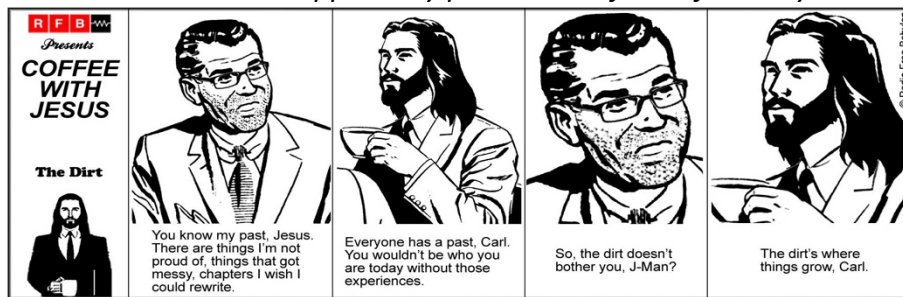

Theological Thoughts

Republished from last week since no one saw it.

My Big Guy told me Lent is a special time in the church year. It lasts 40 days. You don't count Sundays because you don't fast on a Sabbath. It's like a double negative.

He said some people give up a habit, or a type of food during Lent. Giving up food sounds silly. But if you want to give up some thing, He put bags marked **40 Days / 40 Items** in the Gathering Areas at each church. The idea is each day, you take an item from your closet and put into the bag. After Easter, take the filled bag and donate it to a charity.

He said some people do something extra during Lent, like praying more, or reading a devotional. He has copies of a devotional called the **Seven Last Words Devotional Guide**. It focuses on last Jesus' sayings, and it has small coloring pages. It is designed for all ages. Full page Coloring Posters are available if you let My Big Guy know you want them.
