Ananias' Theological Thoughts

This is more of what My Big Guy asked me to write about the colors of the church year and the paraments.

The seasons of the church year start in Advent. My Big Guy calls that group **ACE**, because it includes Advent, Christmas and Epiphany.

Advent starts four Sundays before Christmas, ends on Christmas Eve and its color is **BLUE**. **Christmas** is 12 days long and like all festivals or seasons about Jesus has the color **WHITE**.

Epiphany is a festival and a season. It starts on January 6 and ends the day before Ash Wednesday. The Time after Epiphany is considered Common Time, just like the Time after Pentecost, and has **GREEN** as the color.

There are some additional festival days about Jesus that are usually when we change into, or out of, Ordinary Time, and those days are **WHITE**.

Those are the Baptism of Jesus (in January), Transfiguration Sunday (the Sunday before Lent begins), Trinity Sunday (next Sunday, the Sunday after Pentecost) and Christ the King Sunday (the Sunday before Advent begins.)

I still haven't seen the Robin family. I want My Big Guy to check on them.
